

Reflection by Fr Aleki Piula

Pentecost Sunday

Today we celebrate the Pentecost, after 50th days of Jesus risen from the dead. It happened this is the day when, true to Jesus' promise, he sent the Holy Spirit to the apostles. The coming of the Spirit changed the apostles and saw the launching of a new community, the church. This day renews the gift of the Spirit in



each one of us and in the Church as a whole. Let stop and reflect on our need of the Spirit, and to dispose ourselves to receive him.

In the first reading from the Acts of the Apostles, Luke describes to us about the descending of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles, and the effect it had on them.

Psalm 104 sings,' Lord, send out your Spirit and renew the face of the earth'.

In the second reading a first letter of saint Paul to the Corinthians, The Holy Spirit gives different gifts to different people, for the good of the Church, the Body of Christ.

In today's Gospel we hear the risen Christ gives the gift of the Holy Spirit to his disciples and inaugurates the mission of the church.

Welcome - Malo e lelei - Bula Vinaka - Talofa lava - Mabuhay - Bienvenue Nei hou ma - Anneunghaseyo - Ayu Bowan - Willkommen - Welkom Haere mai! Nau mai! Whakatau mai! On the feast of Pentecost, people were amazed when they heard and saw the apostles, filled with the Holy Spirit, speaking in different languages, and proclaiming the marvels of God (Acts 2:1-11).

Imagine what the Holy Spirit can do to ordinary men called by Jesus to proclaim His Gospel. When Jesus appeared to them after His resurrection, He breathed on them and said: 'Receive the Holy Spirit. For those whose sins you forgive, they are forgiven; for those whose sins you retain, they are retained' (John 20:23) Jesus empowered His apostles to forgive sins by the power of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit can do anything to those who receive Him. So, what do the Spirit do to us? the Spirit will falling afresh on us, will settle us down physically, emotionally and spiritually when we feel weary. The Spirit will melt our hard hearts when we find it difficult to forgive and reconcile with our enemies. The Spirit will mold our unbendable ways, our bad habits and immature behaviour. The Spirit will fill our emptiness when we feel lonely and depressed. The Spirit will use us to be instruments of the Good News wherever we are sent to serve God. As this new week let us ask the Holy Spirit to kindle in us in love and to help us doing his mission.


Bishop Steve and the ACFL Board wish to assist preference families who genuinely need support with Attendance Dues through the ACFL Financial Assistance Scheme.

Personal care – shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrushes, soap, toilet paper.


Household – laundry and dishwashing liquid, spray and wipe. Donations can be <u>dropped off at De Paul House</u>
