

Reflection by Fr Aleki Piula

Anyone who does not accept his cross is not 22

worthy of me. Anyone who welcomes you, welcomes me



Today's readings is about accepting death to receive life, This is a paradox! And the common theme of all readings is the witnessing mission that Christ is given to his followers is to love God and their brothers and sisters through hospitality, generosity, and commitment in humble service and to practice the spiritual works of charity and mercy. The reading always reminds us of the sacrifice demanded of Jesus Christ to his disciples and with the suffering they will endure for their Faith when they bear witness to Christ. So we are in God's house, God is the host, we are the guests. We should feel welcome and at home here, God accepts us therefore, we should accept one another.

In the first reading from the book of the second Kings. A beautiful act of hospitality is rewarded by God to the Shunem woman who welcome given to the prophet Elisha. The wife recognized the holiness of Elisha, she showed him reverence and hospitality by inviting him to dine with her and her husband and arranging the upper room for prophet Elisha. Then Elisha said to Her: 'This time next year you will be fondling a baby son'. The woman gave later birth to a son, but then the child died so she went to find Elisha and he heals her son and bring him back to life (2kings 4:16-37)



Psalm 89 sings, 'Forever I will sing the goodness of the Lord'. This Psalm reminds us that we are the children of God who tell us, that His mercy and kindness is established forever'.

Welcome - Malo e lelei - Bula Vinaka - Talofa lava - Mabuhay - Bienvenue Nei hou ma - Anneunghaseyo - Ayu Bowan - Willkommen - Welkom Haere mai! Nau mai! Whakatau mai! In the second reading a letter of saint Paul to the Romans. Having been buried with him through baptism, we shall walk in a new life. For Paul in our baptism, we are into Jesus' death and buried with him. In Baptism we are united to the death and resurrection of Christ. Since Baptism is our entree into this new life, it makes us part of the Body of Christ, and Christ is truly present in us.

In today's Gospel, it stresses the sacrifices involved in being missionaries of Jesus, and also the greatness of even the smallest act of hospitality offered to those missionaries. Jesus says, 'Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it'. Jesus encourages the twelve to follow him in his footsteps. then he

will always lead them. Whoever does not take up the cross and follow me is not worthy of me. So how will I follow him today?

Food Bank Depleted! Can you help? Our shelves are looking bare in most products.

With disasters now coming in twos the need for food and bed clothing, in particular new pillows and single duvets, has doubled. Foodstuffs – med-large tins of tuna/salmon/tinned corned beef, pasta sauces, meal sauces, tea, coffee, milo, long-life milk, biscuits, crackers, mueslibars, cereal, rice, jam, honey, peanut butter.

Personal care – shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrushes, soap, toilet paper.

Household – laundry and dishwashing liquid, spray and wipe. Donations can be dropped off at De Paul House
Office at 92-96 Onewa Rd, Northcote.

Items left in the baskets at the back of the church do not go to De Paul House and that the food for St Vincent de Paul needs to be <u>non-perishable</u>.
