Trust and Accountability

As we gather here today no two of us are alike. God has given each of us special gifts or talents. If we used well, these gifts will enrich our own lives and the lives of others. But which of us can say that we have made full use of the gifts of grace and nature that God has given us? Have we not at times left them unused, or, worse, misused them?

In the first reading from the book of Proverbs, by today's standards the woman at the centre of this reading would hardly be called a talented person. Yet she is held up as a model.

Psalm 128 sings, 'Happy are those who fear the Lord'. The Old Testament is fond of repeating that the fear of God is the beginning of wisdom. This does not refer to that sort of cowering fear which fills one with dread, paralysing action, as happened to the servant in the parable who buried his talent because he was scared of his master. The fear of God which is a virtue means

humble reverence before God and respect for God's laws. The psalmist sees this reverential fear as the foundation of happy and prosperous family life.

In the second reading from the first letter of saint Paul to the Thessalonians, since they don't know exactly when the Lord will return, Paul urges the disciples to be always ready lest they be caught unawares.

In today's Gospel, the parable of the talents tells us how best to await the Lord's return. The parable of the wise and foolish virgins warned against not being ready for the delay. it was an introduction to the theme of living the in between time. In today's Gospel, Jesus moves on from the parable of the wise and foolish virgins to develop further what it means to be watchful and faithful during the time of waiting.

The parable of the talents presents two lessons about God and Man. The first lesson is God's trust in man. The second is Man's accountability to God. God is rich in His bountiful gift of talents but let us ask him that we exercise them with joy and courage. Today's Gospel challenges us to do something positive, constructive and life-affirming with the talents we have right here and now.
