Preparing the way of the Lord

All three readings today focus on the absolutely necessity of our getting ready for Christmas. It is about repentance, preparing, praying and renewal of our lives. It also reminds us the past coming of Jesus 2000 years ago, the daily present of Jesus in the Eucharistic celebration, through the Scriptures and

the praying of the community and his future coming that is his second coming are actually the fulfillment of God's plan for us from all eternity.

In the first reading from prophet Isaiah, the people are urged to prepare a way for the Lord who is coming to save them.

Psalm 85 sings, 'Let us see, O Lord, your mercy and give us your saving help'


In the second reading, second letter of Peter. If the Lord appears to be slow in coming, it is to give people an opportunity to be ready to meet him when he comes.

In todays' Gospel John the Baptist urges the people to prepare for the imminent coming of the Saviour. Isaiah's word point the way to the messianic era this leads into the Gospel like a new
