Cleansing of the Temple

We are on third Sunday of Lent and our readings teach us about to clean out the temple of our own hearts and to offer to God a proper

worship by obeying the Ten Commandments. It also teach us how to be holy by repentance and allowing the Holy Spirit to control our lives. Today we are gathering here in the house of God, a house of prayer and worship. Let us reflect a moment on the attitude we bring to our worship this morning.


In the first reading from the book of Exodus. the Ten commandments are a map of life for a people that has a special relationship with God.

Psalm 19 sings, 'Lord, you have the words of everlasting life'. This psalm responds to the gift of God's guidance in the commandments. The Law of the Lord is perfect. It revives the soul. It gives wisdom to the simple and light to the eyes. It is more to be desired than gold, sweeter than honey.

In the second reading the first letter of saint Paul to the Corinthians, here Paul preached a

crucified Christ. To some the idea made no sense. To others it was a sign of the wisdom and power of God.



In today's Gospel, by chasing the money changers and sellers of sacrificial animals out of the Temple, Jesus passed judgement on the Jewish system of worship. Jesus stops all business transactions in the temple.

The Jews demand an explanation from him for his actions. His response is: 'Destroy this Temple, and in three days I will raise it up'. Jesus was speaking of the temple of his body and thus predicting his death and resurrection. For Christians Jesus is the new temple or the place of encounter with God.

Jesus is the way, and no one can go to the Father except through him (John 14:6). He who has seen Jesus has seen the Father because he is in the Father and the Father is in him (John 14:9-10).

Have a blessed Sunday, God bless Fr. Aleki.
