Reflection by Fr Aleki Piula



All who live in love, live in God, and God In them

Today's reading declare the profound truth that those who believe in Christ are to obey his commandment of love and to love one another as (Jesus) has loved (them). As we think about our mother which they generate to practice the agape love of Jesus. Today's Gospel reminds us the commandment Christ left his disciples: 'Love one another as I have loved you'. It was God who first loved us. As we call to mind God's love for us in Christ and let us also call to mind that our response to that love is to love one another.

In the first reading from the Acts of the Apostles, we see the baptism of Cornelius, the first Gentile to receive the grace of baptism, shows that God's salvation is offered to all.

Psalm 98 sings, 'The Lord has revealed to the nations his saving power'. This psalm directs our attention toward God's marvellous love and kindness in offering salvation to the whole world.

In the second reading from the first letter of saint John, this contains what is probably the most important statement ever made about God. John tells us that God is Love, expresses His love for

us mankind by sending His only beloved Son to the world to die for us humans as expiation for our sins.

If you're sick, please stay HOME

So, this Divine love gives us the command and the duty to love one another as we have been loved by God, Since God loved us first, we can love God in return.

In today's Gospel, Jesus leaves his friends the supreme commandment of love. Love is the only way we can really know God and share in God's life. The image of God is at its best and brightest in us when we love, because where love is, God is Jesus tells his disciples of the greatness of his love for them, he lays down his life for them, as they are now his friends. They are dear to him because he has chosen them to be his own. Chosen to live within this communion of love, the believer lives as fruitful life, and receives whatever she or he asks of the Father. As St John said in his old ages, 'Little children, love one another', because 'If you do that, you do enough'.
